



## **NOTICE ENGAGEMENT IN PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**

1. We refer to the Consultant Booklet which governs your relationship with Nefful Singapore Holdings Pte. Ltd. (the “**Company**”). The Consultant Booklet prescribes the scope of permitted activities you may undertake in your capacity as a distributor of the Company.
2. Pursuant to the Consultant Booklet, you are hereby reminded that if you shall at any time engage in any of the following prohibited activities (“**Prohibited Activities**”):
  - (1) attempt to influence, instigate and/or recruit members of the Company into joining another multi-level marketing company;
  - (2) invite or persuade any of the Company’s members to attend another multi-level marketing company’s events and promotional activities; or
  - (3) intentionally place yourself in a position of conflict of interest between the Company and another multi-level marketing company,the Company will have the following rights against you:
  - (i) terminate your distributorship;
  - (ii) cease the payment of further bonus to you;
  - (iii) bar you from re-applying to join the Company as a member; and
  - (iv) revoke all rights attached to your membership account with the Company.
3. In addition, please note that pursuant to Section 3 of the Multi-Level Marketing and Pyramid Selling (Prohibition) Act (the “**Act**”), it is unlawful for any person to promote or participate in a multi-level marketing scheme or arrangement or a pyramid selling scheme or arrangement, or hold out that he is promoting or participating in such a scheme or arrangement, unless such scheme or arrangement satisfies the conditions as prescribed in the Multi-Level Marketing and Pyramid Selling (Excluded Schemes and Arrangements) (Amendments) Order 2001 (the “**Order 2001**”).
4. Any attempt to influence, instigate and/or recruit members of the Company into joining another multi-level marketing scheme or arrangement that fails to comply the Act and the Order 2001 is not permitted and is illegal.
5. Any person who contravenes Section 3 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$200,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years or both.
6. In light of the above, you are advised to refrain from engaging in any Prohibited Activity.
